Character fit: Traydyn is the long-lost, older half brother of Handsome Jack, the main villain of *Borderlands 2*. He is a collector of rare, vintage (read: obsolete) weapons, and purveyor of modern arms. Above all else, he is a man with impeccable taste—just ask him. When Traydyn was six, his father traded him to an arms dealer for a vintage rocker launcher. Traydyn hated his father for doing that, and hates Handsome Jack even more, because how come his father kept him instead? What makes Jack so valuable? If you bring Traydyn your rarest, most vintage-y weapons, he will gladly take them off your hands, offering you the latest, most advanced, most powerful, trendiest weapons in exchange. Traydyn would never be caught dead using something so gauche, but for someone with your gaudy taste, they'll do just fine.

What Traydyn wants: The finest collection of rare, vintage weapons in all of Pandora. He has a list of guns he wants you to bring him, though they're probably so cool you haven't heard of them. Also, if you could kill Handsome Jack, that tasteless buffoon, that would be great too.

If Traydyn acquires the finest collection of weapons in Pandora ... you'll never hear the end of it. But he'll reward you with weapons more powerful than you could imagine. And if you kill Handsome Jack, maybe Traydyn will stop using material things to fill the hole left in his heart from when his father abandoned him. But probably not.

If Traydyn doesn't get what he wants, he supposes he'll have to live like the rest of you swine, content with life's most basic accessories. If you can even call that a life.
